All workshops are included in the registration fees and in some workshops the material will be provided by the organization.


Monday, 13th

Which will be the place chosen to carry out some workshops or masterclass, either inside the venue or in the "Poble Espanyol" auditorium.



This place is a unique space to carry out cultural and family activities, within an architectural complex where you can find recreations of the different building styles in Spain. The complex is made up of 117 full-scale buildings, with houses, a theatre, a school, a church and craft shops.

At the entrance we find the towers of Ávila, then a walk through a typical Andalusian neighbourhood, architecture from Galicia etc, streets and squares that make up this unique town in the centre of

Barcelona, near Plaza España and the MNAC National Museum in the area known as Montjuïc. We hope you like it and discover a new space within Barcelona.


Place: LLOTJA – BARCELONA HIGHER SCHOOL OF ART AND DESIGN

This exhibition coincides with the 250th anniversary of the founding of the **LLOTJA**, the art and design school in Barcelona, one of the oldest in Europe. Its name comes from the fact that its first classrooms were set up in the Llotja de Mar (Sea Market), where great figures in the world art world have passed through such as Marià Fortuny, Joaquim Mir, Nonell, Miró, Jaume Plensa and other great artists such as Picasso, who studied painting before travelling to Paris.

Friday 17th

Excursion and visit to the coastal town of SITGES, departure by coach from Barcelona to visit this tourist and fishing town, located southwest of Barcelona and surrounded by the Garraf natural park. It has a train station and can be reached in 40 minutes from Barcelona.

Sitges is known for its promenade and beaches, as well as the old town and its streets with typical shops, restaurants, bars, etc. but its current economy is based on tourism and culture. The Sitges Fantastic Film Festival is held here. In the past, they were more dedicated to farming and vineyards, and Malvasía de Sitges wine is still made there

We can also visit the Palau Maricel and the Cau Ferrat Museum located in the house-studio of the painter and writer Santiago Rusiñol, one of the leading figures of modernism in Catalonia, where old works of art collected by the artist are exhibited (painting, wrought iron, ceramics, glass, archaeology, sculpture and furniture).

Sitges also has a bronze sculpture by Pere Jou, located on the sea front by the steps of the church, Saint Bartolomé and Santa Tecla. It is a mermaid with her hand worn due to people returning her greeting.


